Fatigue Stress Concentration Factors K_f is normally used in fatigue calculations but is sometimes used with static stresses K_t Convenient to think of K_f as a stress concentration factor reduced from K_t because of lessened sensitivity to notches K_f If notch sensitivity data is not available, it is conservative to use K_t in fatigue calculations
